Minutes of the Open Meeting held on Thursday 15th November,
2018.

Chair's opening Remarks: Cllr Booth opened the meeting by expressing thanks, on behalf of the whole community, to the Paxton family for the sterling job they have done over the last 30 years and wishing them a happy and healthy retirement.

Councillors had been approached by residents with questions and ideas about possible future amenities and so thought it appropriate to hold this meeting to start the ball rolling by seeing what interest there was and allowing residents to share ideas.

She expressed the Parish Council view that for the longevity of a community facility it needs to have a community lead and talked about neighbouring villages who have introduced a community facility.
