An Update on St. Mary's Church Restoration

Having received grants from Kirkby Fleetham Parish Council and the Sir John Priestman Trust, we are now able to go ahead with the planned development of the Lady Chapel into a refreshment / hospitality area. This will involve removing the 5 pews and replacing the deteriorating wooden flooring with a limecrete floor topped off with heritage flagstones.

Work will start on July 1st and be completed by the end of that month. It won't affect any of the services scheduled for July.

Kirkby Fleetham Village Hall

There are two exciting new developments at the Village Hall. The Kirkby Fleetham Gardening Club is currently creating a gardening space in the outdoor area behind the Library Room – we will provide more detail on this as it progresses. In addition, a **General Exercise for Older Men** session began in May and is proving to be a popular new activity every Thursday morning.

A full programme of activities continues with exercise classes, Yoga, Armchair Cinema, Bridge Club, carpet bowls, sound bath relaxation and ballroom dancing. The Women's Institute, Book Lovers, History, Gardening and Parent & Baby groups meet regularly, and new members are always welcome. Details of these activities can be found at Kirkby Fleetham with Fencotes Parish Council Village Hall

The Village Hall hosts a schedule of regular events, which includes the popular "Hub" on Wednesday and Saturday mornings between 10.15–12.15, offering cakes, bacon butties and hot drinks, and **Church Coffee** mornings which are held on the first Saturday of every month.

The Parish Council as well as the Feast, Village Hall, Gardening and Hub committees meet in the Hall and we host one-off events, such

as plays, talks, music evenings and pizza nights. The Hall is also used as a polling station during elections.

Facilities include a large hall with projector and sound equipment, a library which is also used for meetings, a well-equipped kitchen and the History & Resources Room. The latter routinely displays photographs and items on a variety of themes. Rooms may be hired online at Kirkby Fleetham with Fencotes Parish Council Village Hall, see link below to website.

A **Mobile Post Office** comes to the Hall car park on Wednesday mornings between 10.00–11.00 am, and a defibrillator is located on the front the building. There is also a selection of greetings cards on sale and there are two electric vehicle charging points in the car park. The **Village Hall Committee** is group of volunteers which meets regularly to manage the facility.

We ask that all users of the Hall familiarise themselves with the safety procedures posted in every room and to report any concerns to a committee member. We are grateful to everybody for leaving the Hall in a clean and tidy condition, but would ask that users double check that any food scraps, or mud inadvertently brought in on shoes, are removed.
